### **Graduate Student Exit Survey Report 2017-18**

**Total Respondents: 219** 

Response Rate: 52.64%

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#### Introduction

The 2018 Graduate Student Exit Survey was sent out by email on May 6, 2018. The survey was sent to a total of 416 Framingham State University graduate students who have completed their degree or were about to complete their degree at the end of the Spring 2018 semester. The Office of Institutional Assessment received 219 completed surveys. The response rate for the survey was 52.64%.

#### **Graduation Rates**






### Did you apply to any other universities for graduate school?



#### How did you finance your graduate education?






# How applicable were the program requirements to your current/or future workplace?


# After completing your graduate program, how would you classify your level of preparation?






### Did you receive your undergraduate degree from FSU?


### Would you select FSU if you were to begin graduate school all over again?


### Would you recommend FSU to other potential students?


### What percentage of your classes did you take online and what percentage would you have preferred?

The question asked respondents to mark the percentage of courses taken online and the percentage they would prefer to take online using a slider that went from 0% - 100%. The table above shows the means for each. Graduate students reported that they took approximately 41% of courses in the online format. Students indicated they would have preferred to have taken 45% of courses online. This indicates that students are generally satisfied with the balance of offerings between face-to-face and online course offerings in graduate studies.


