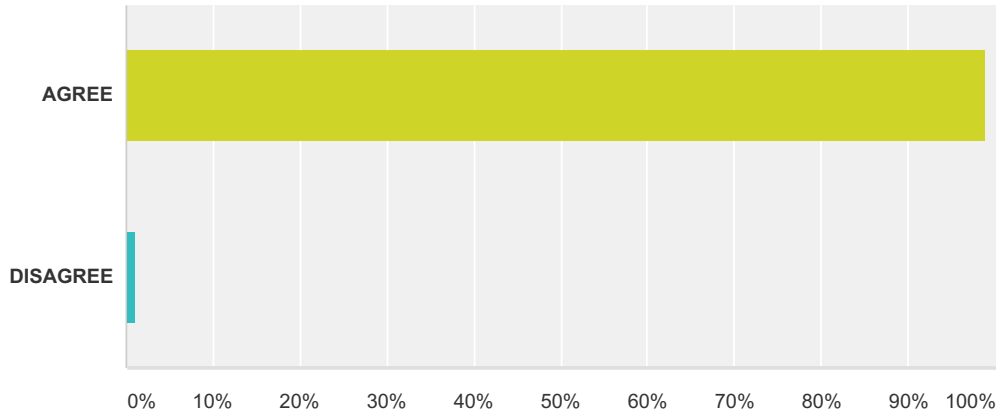

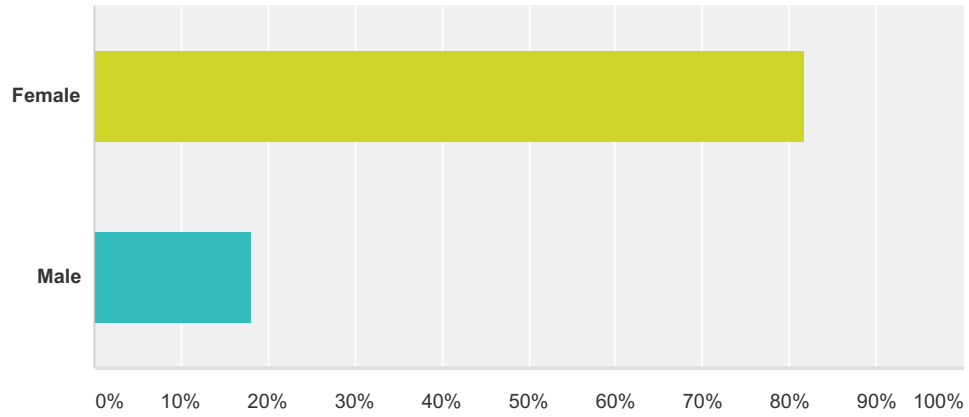

## Q2 What is your biological sex?

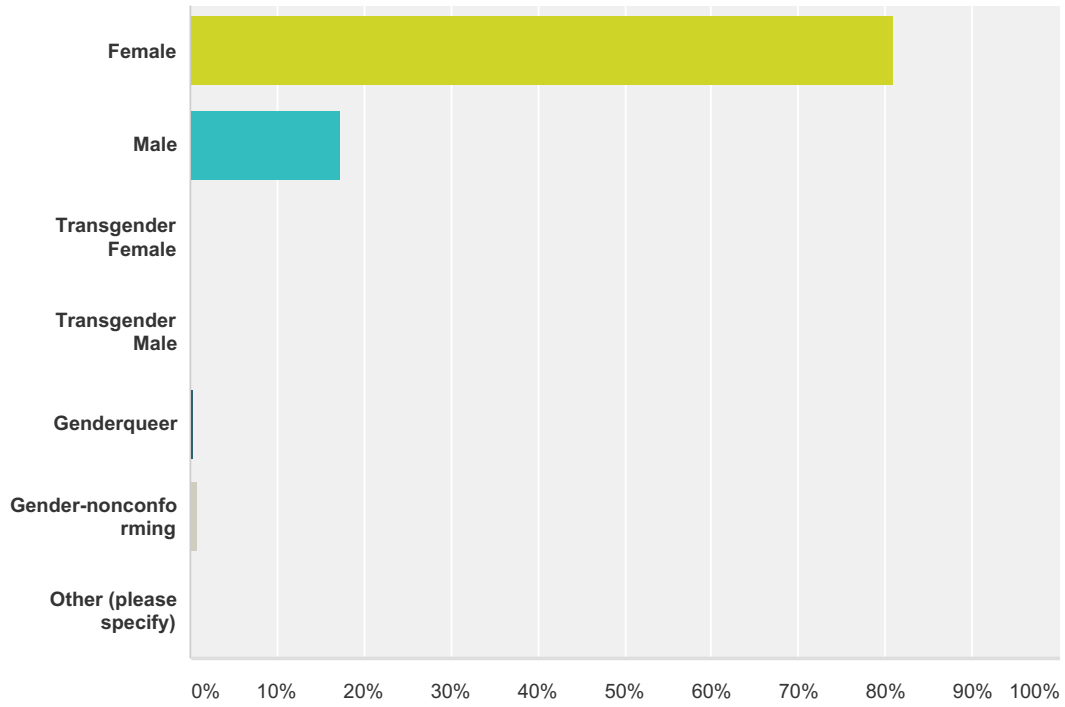

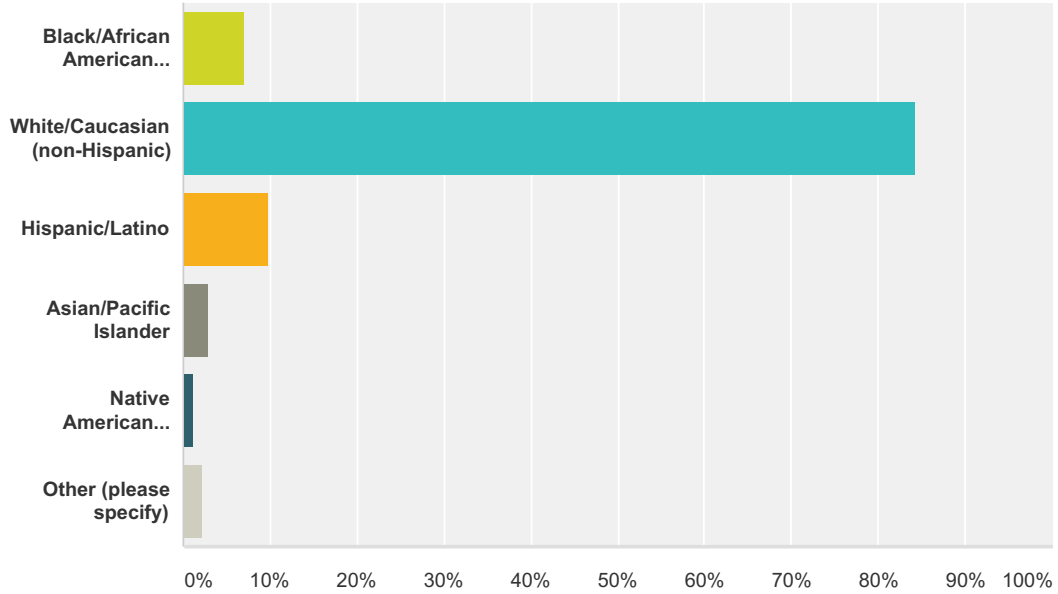

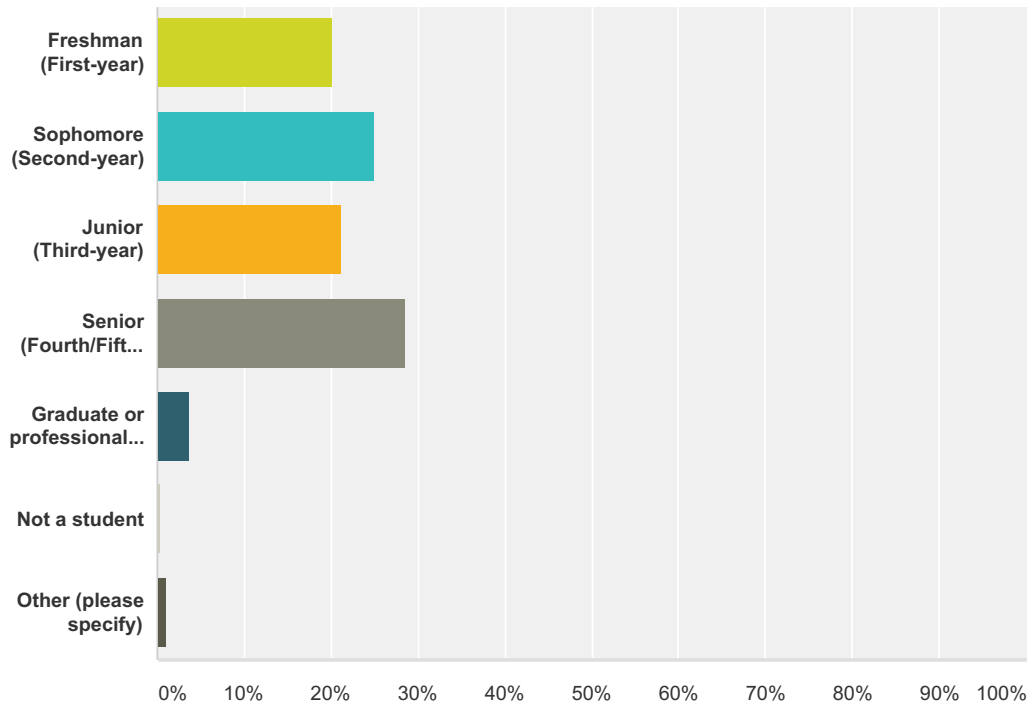

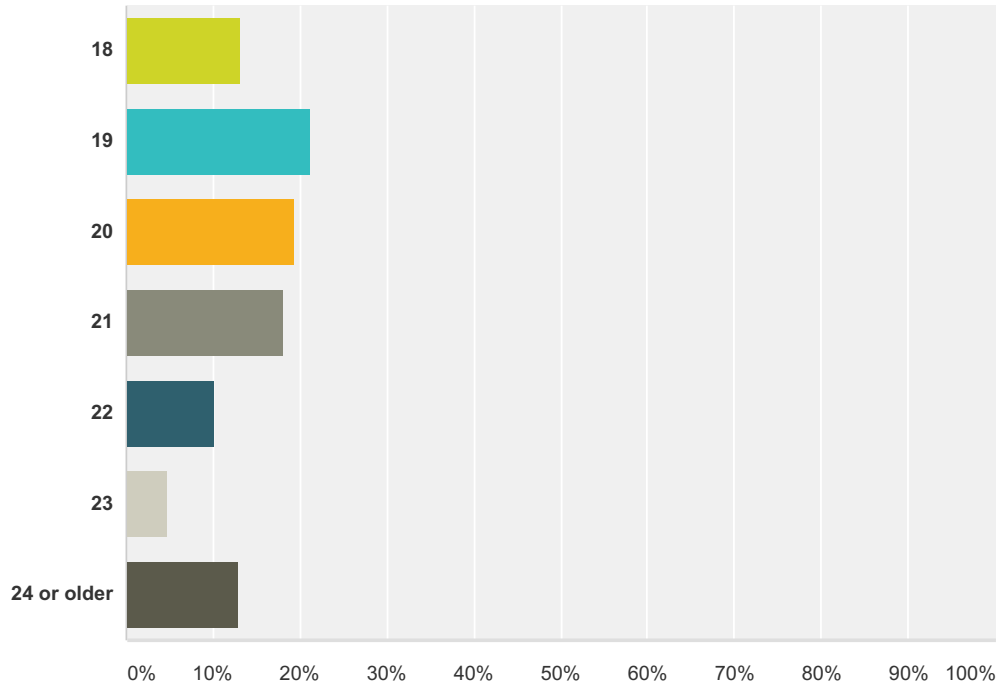

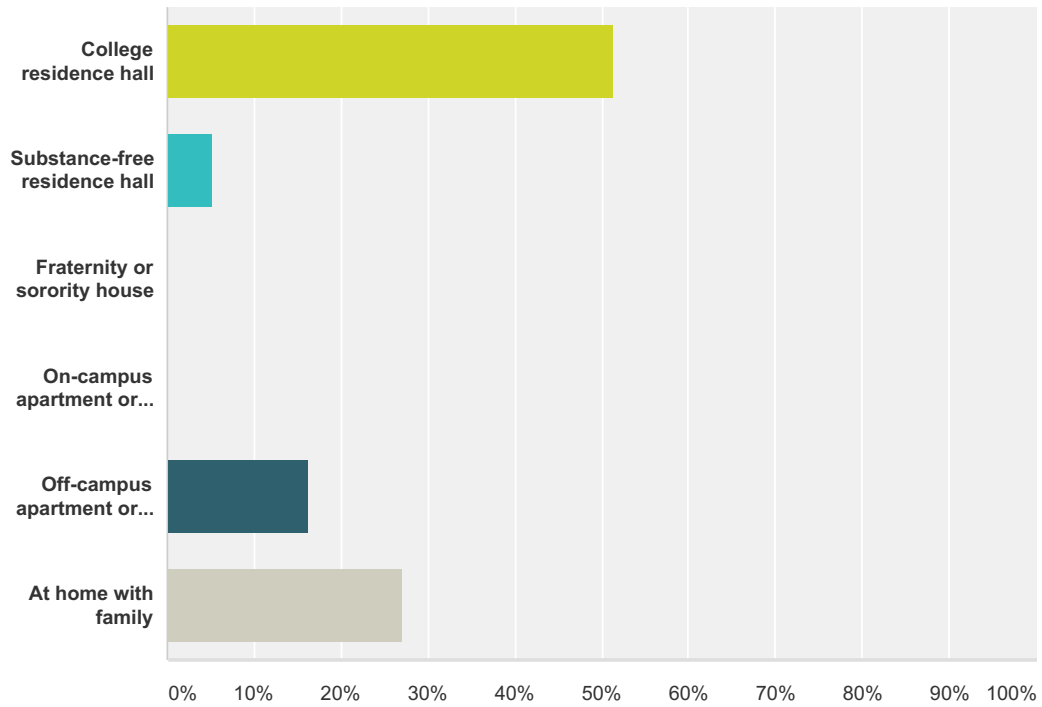

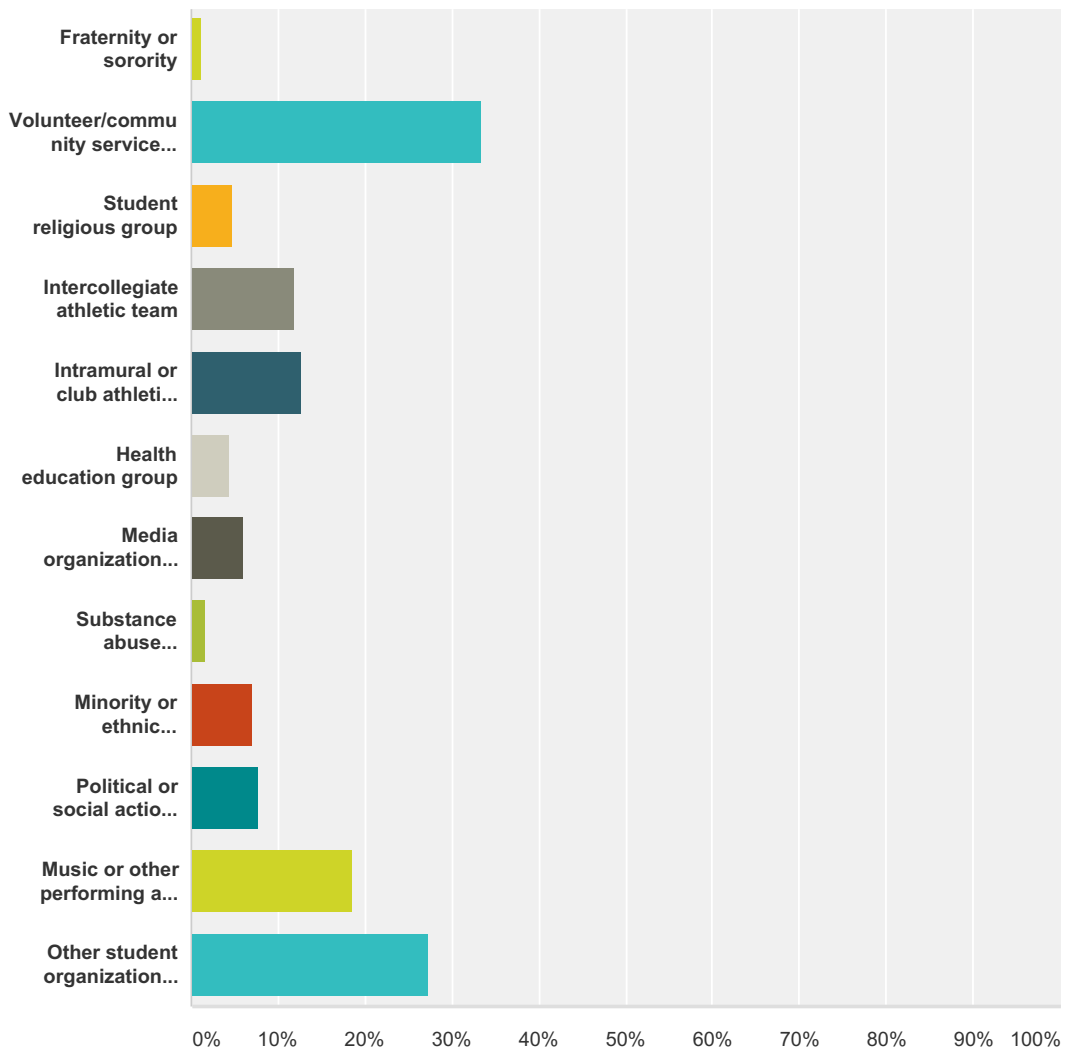

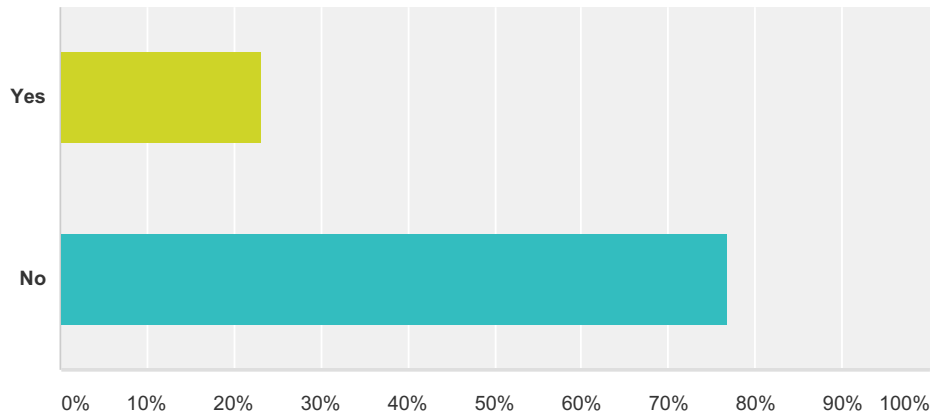

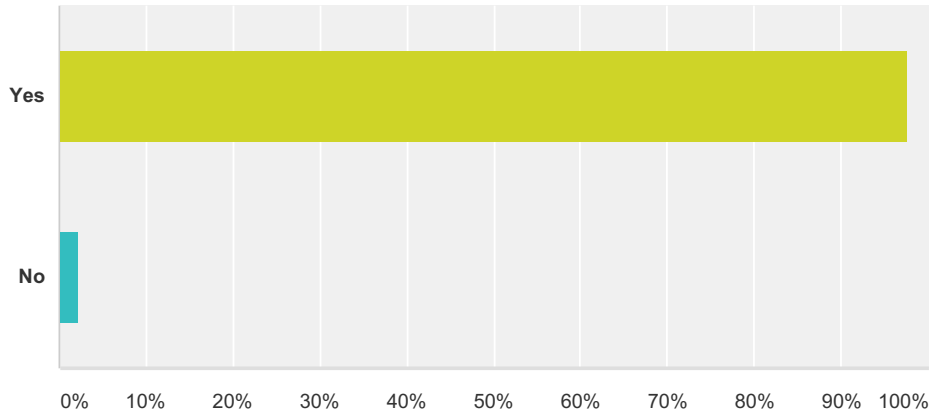

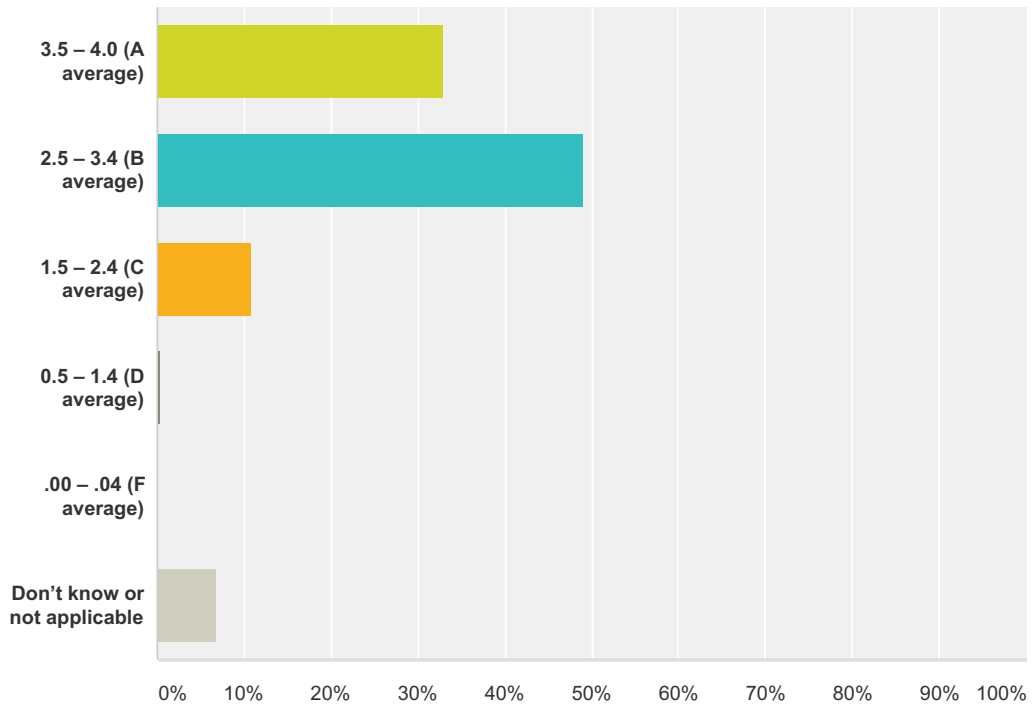

### Q14 Which of the following best describes your current grade point average?

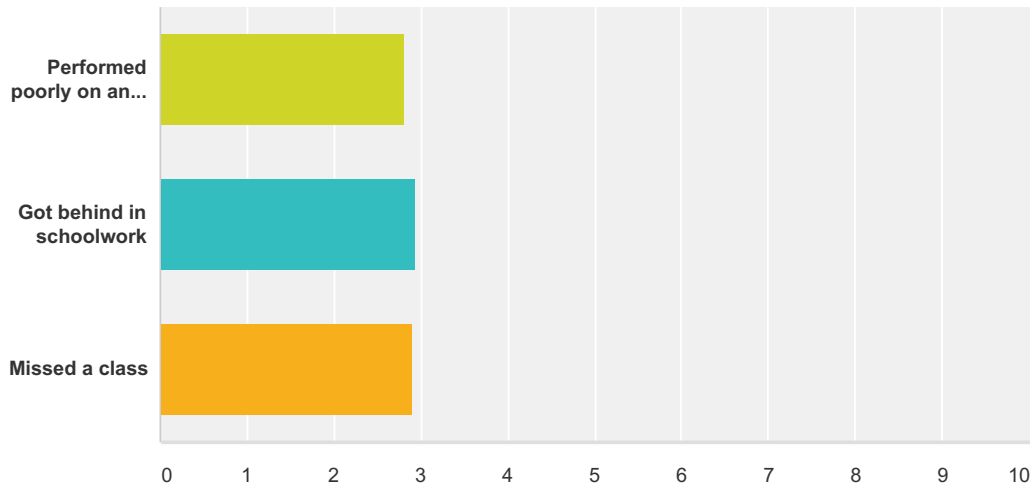

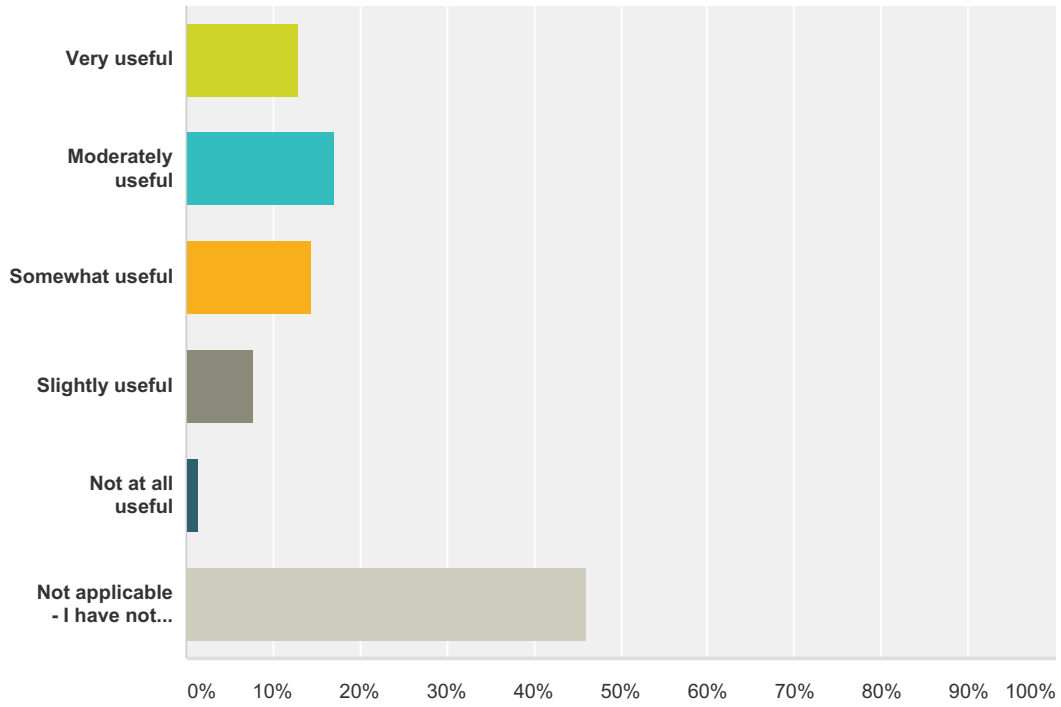

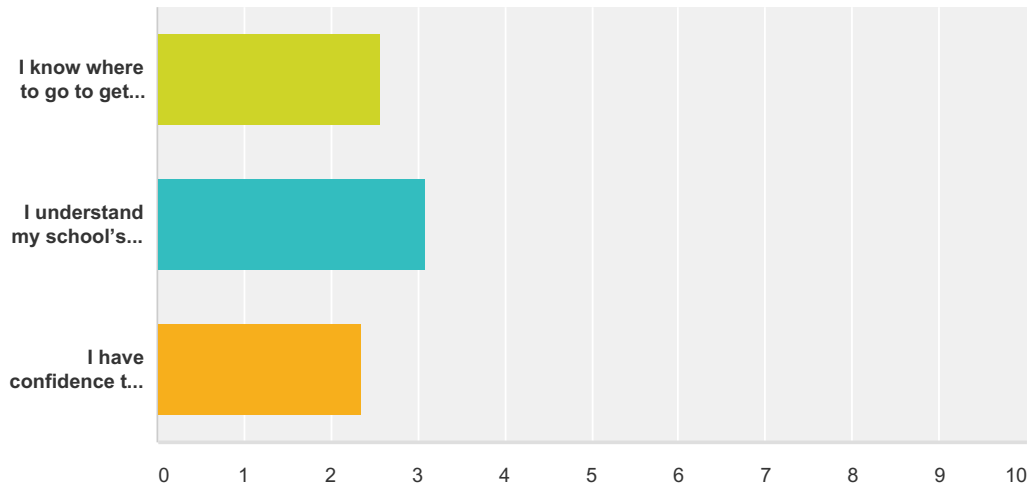

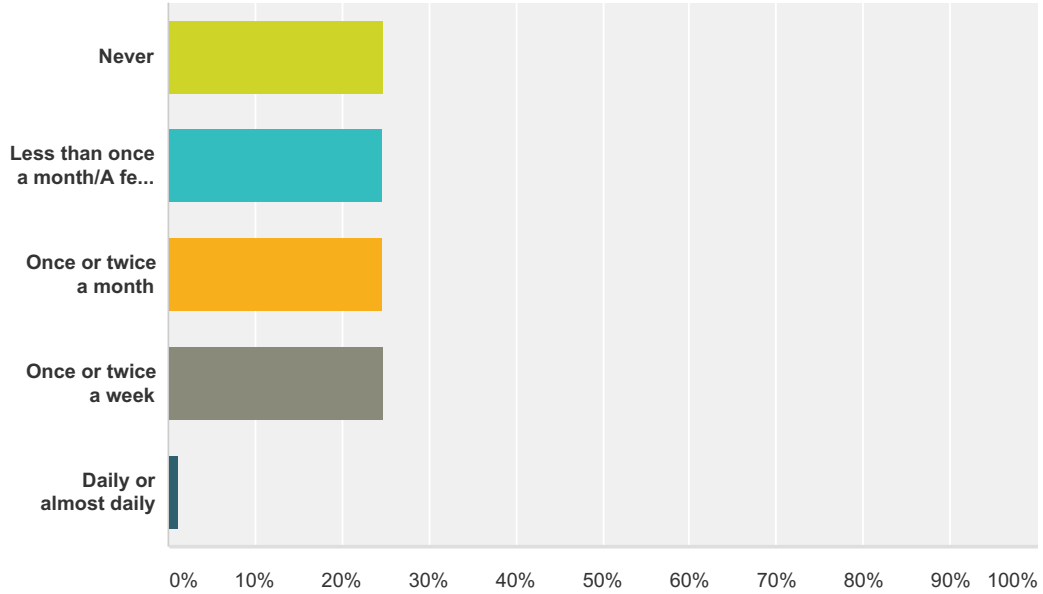

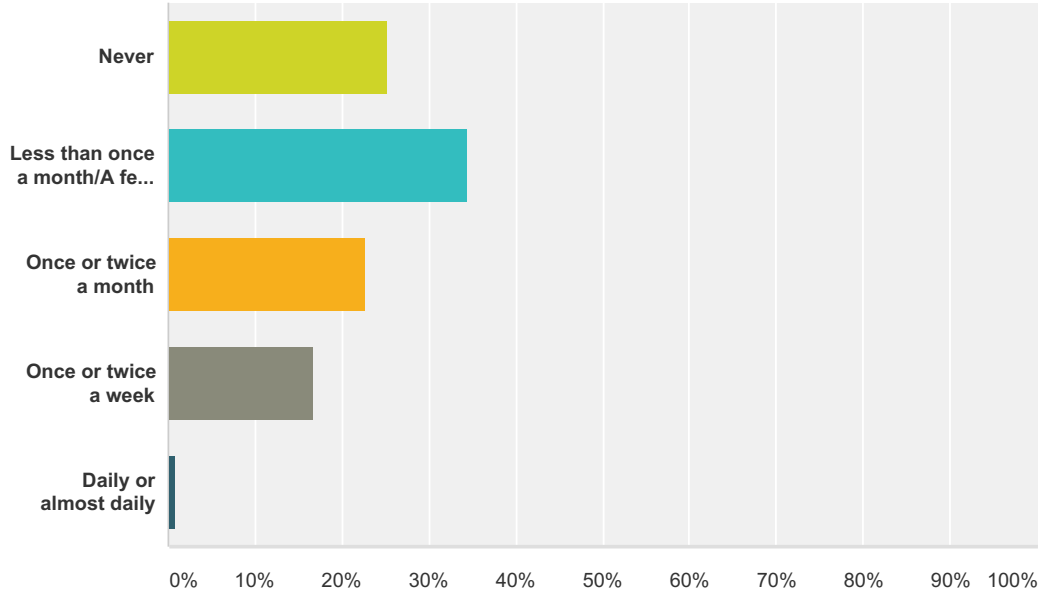

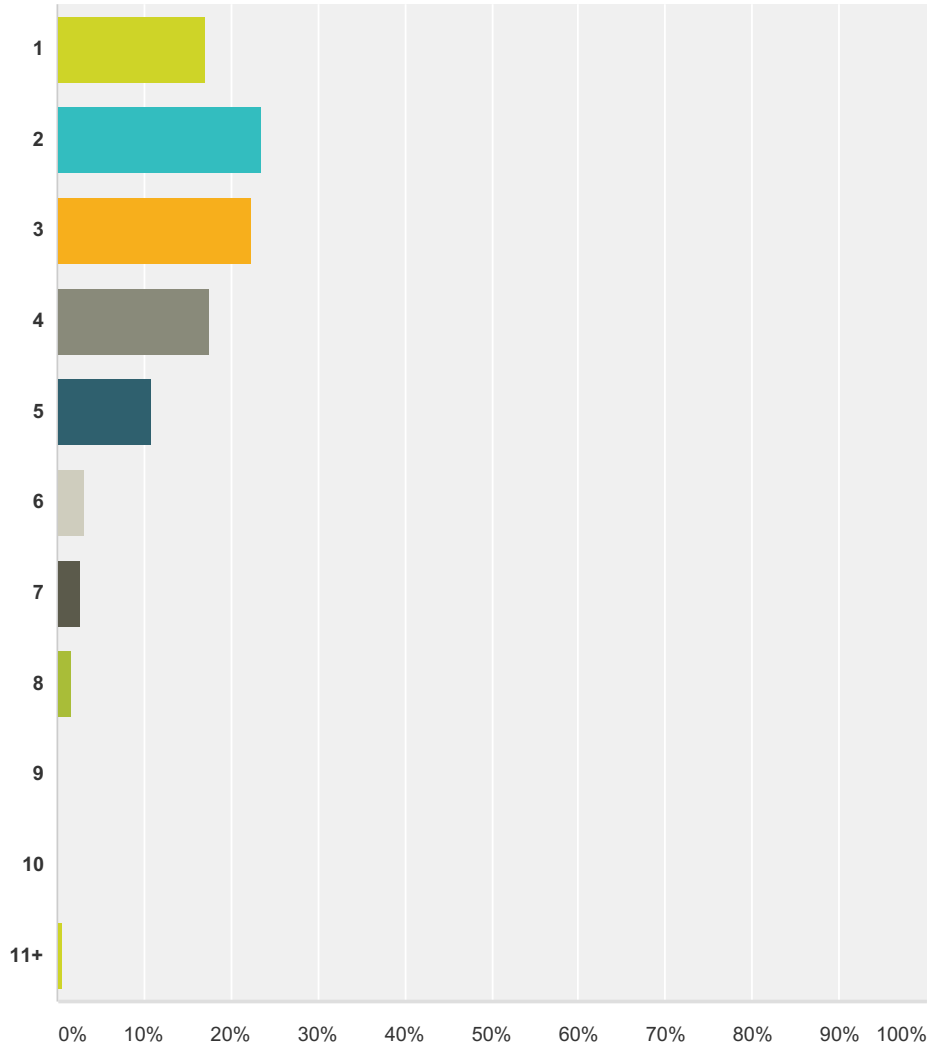

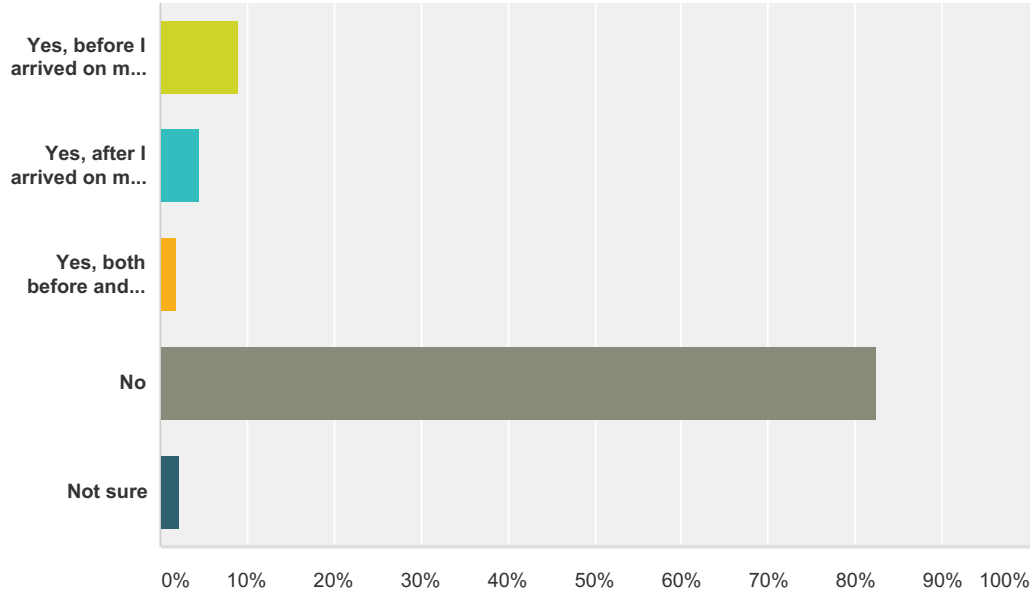

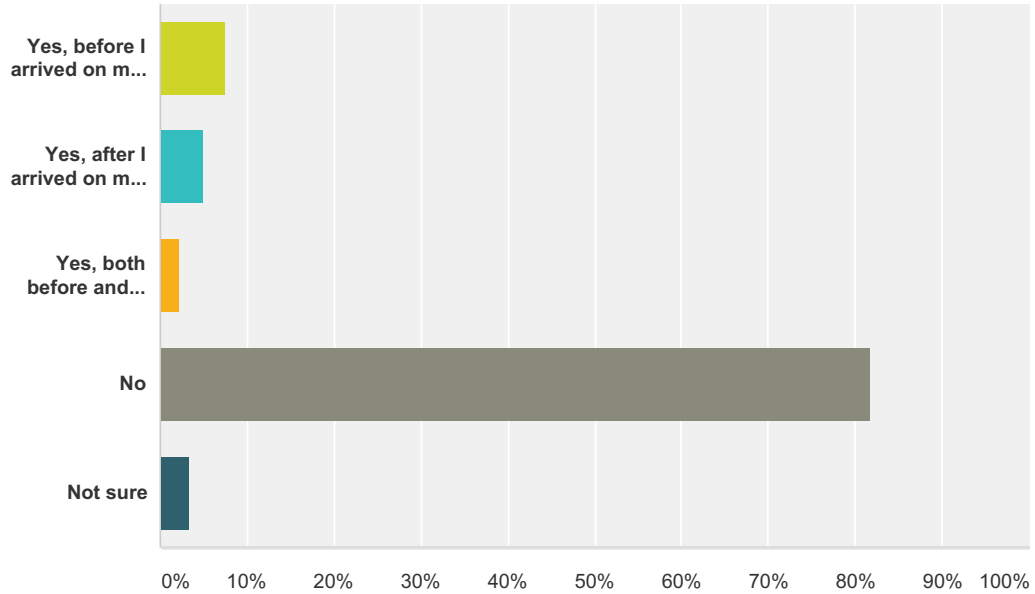

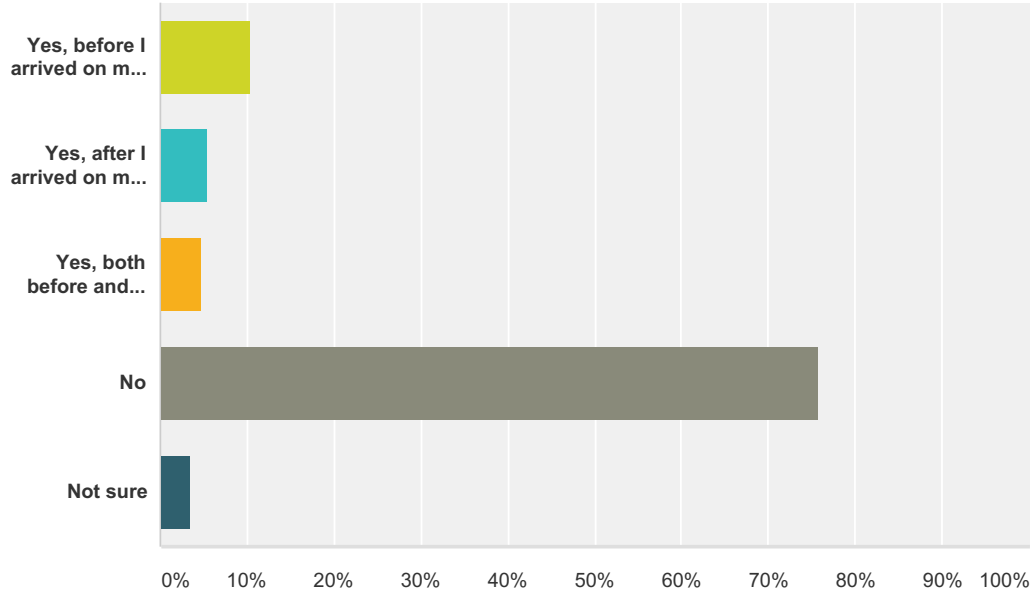

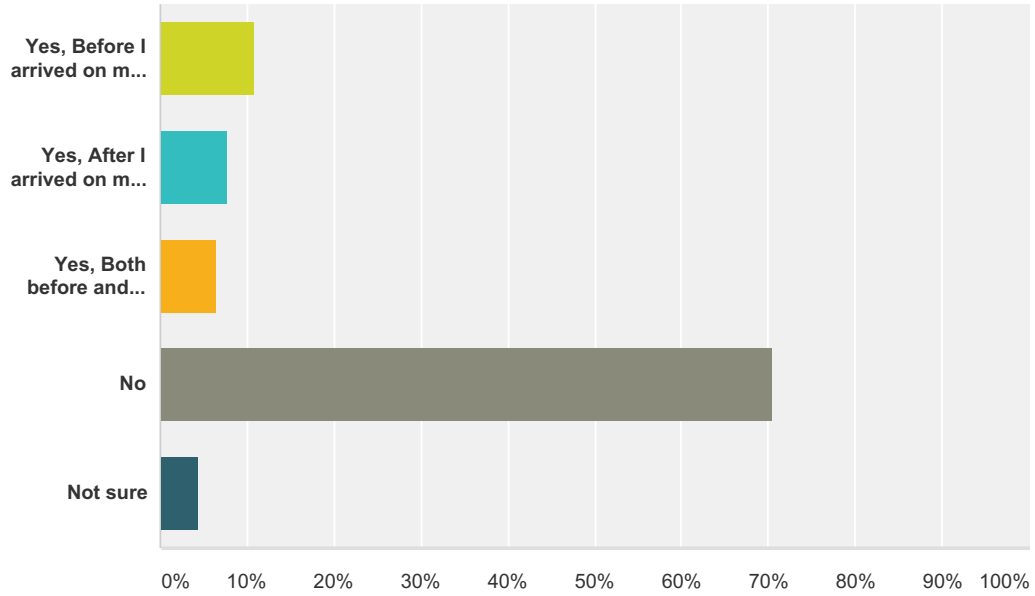

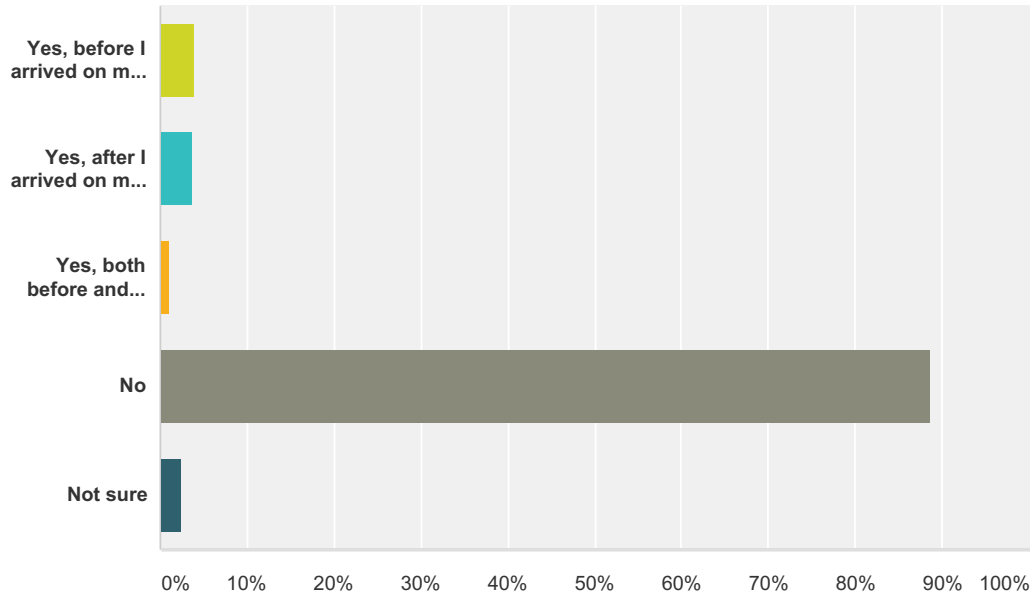

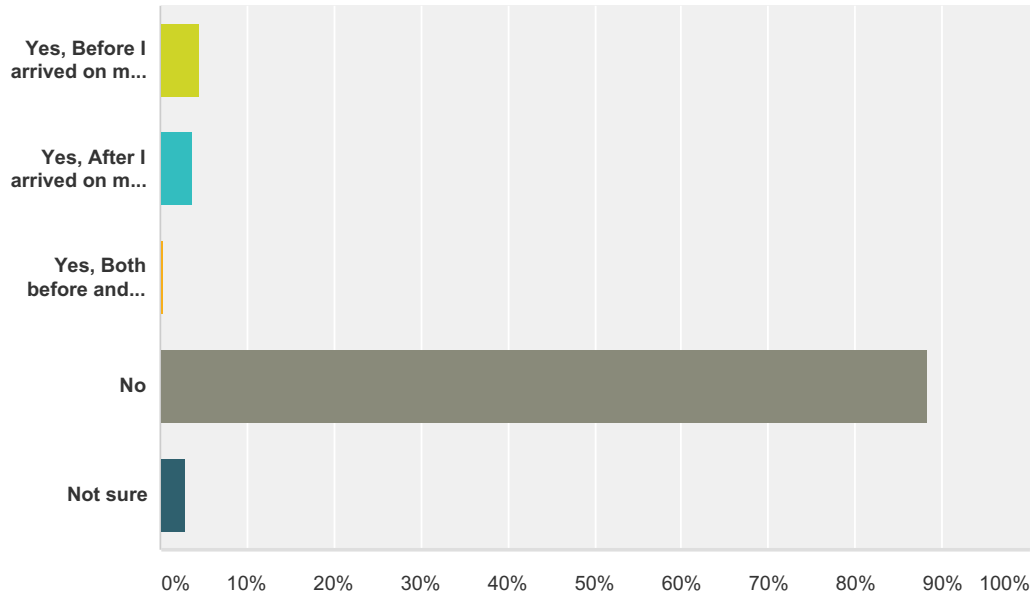

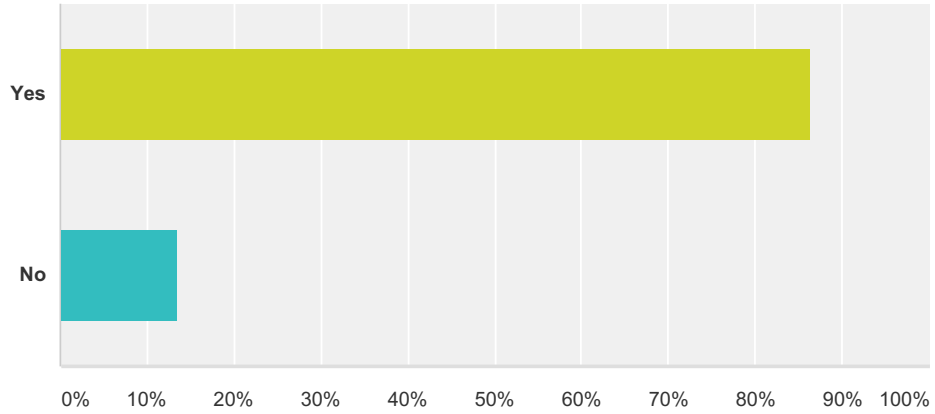

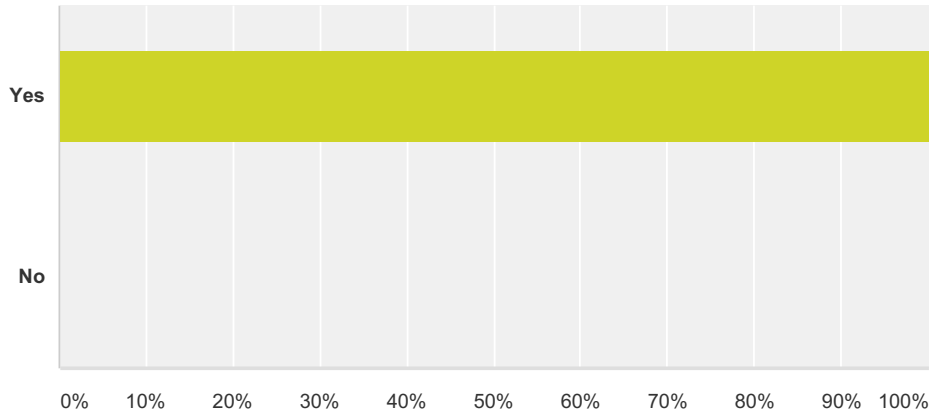

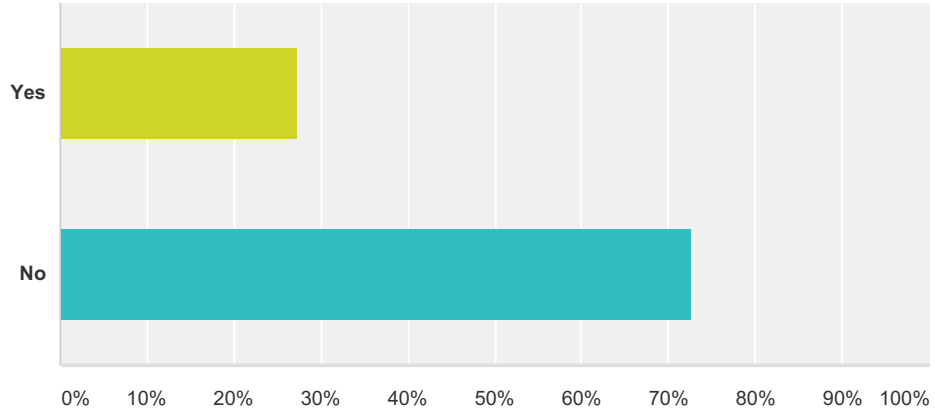

**Q35 Just prior to the incident, had you voluntarily been taking or using any drugs other than alcohol?**

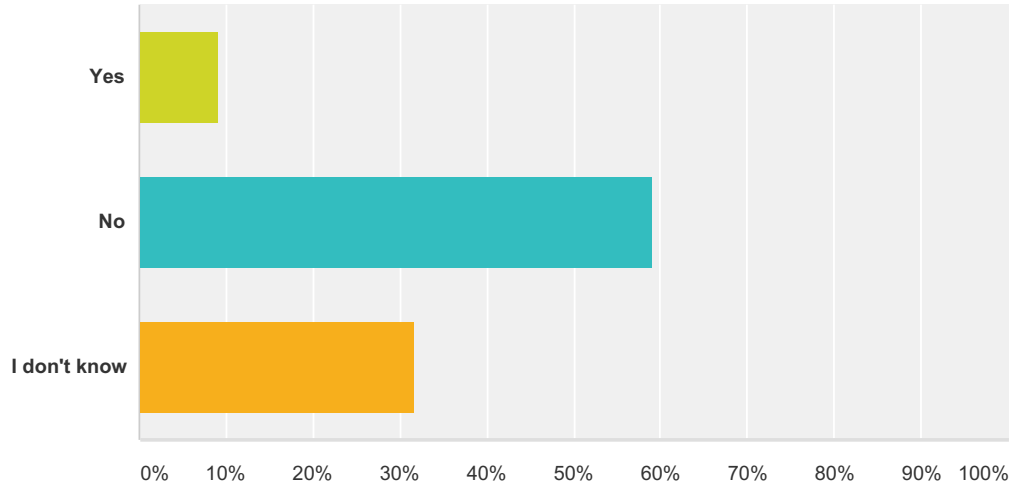

**Q36 Just prior to the incident, had you been given a drug without your knowledge or consent?**

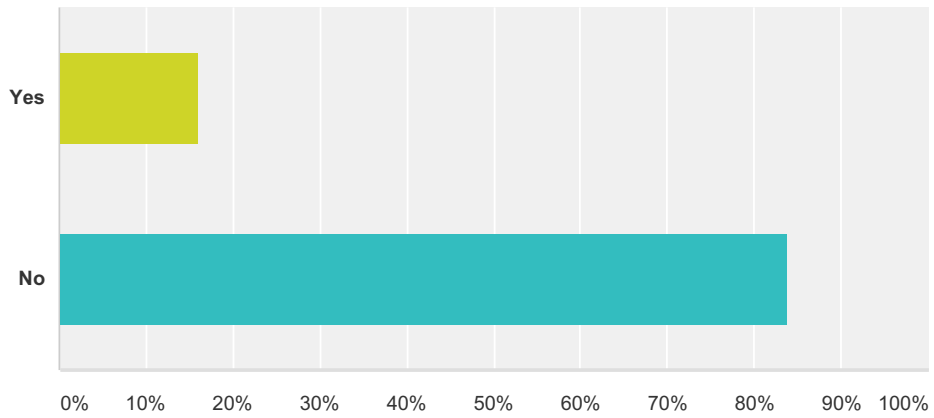

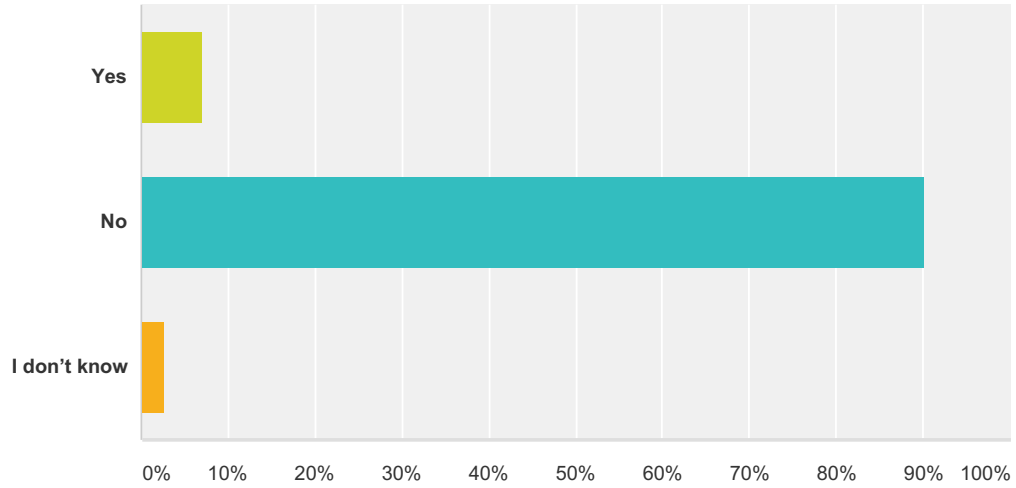

**Q40 Was this person affiliated with your school, as an employee, staff, or faculty member?**

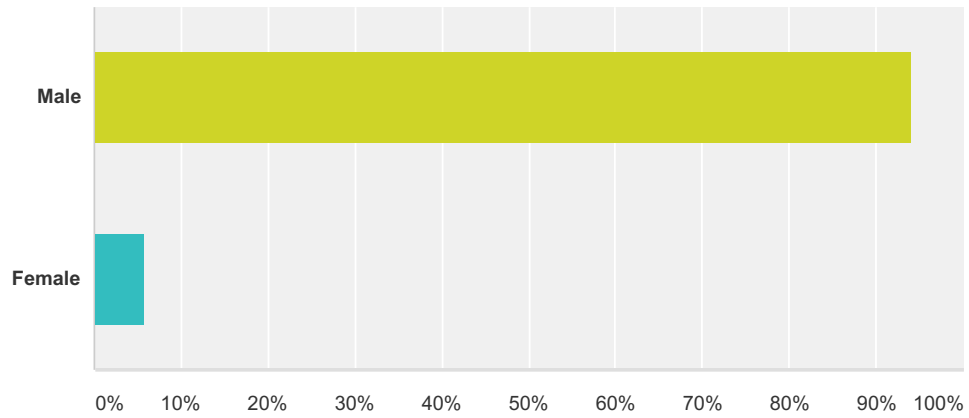

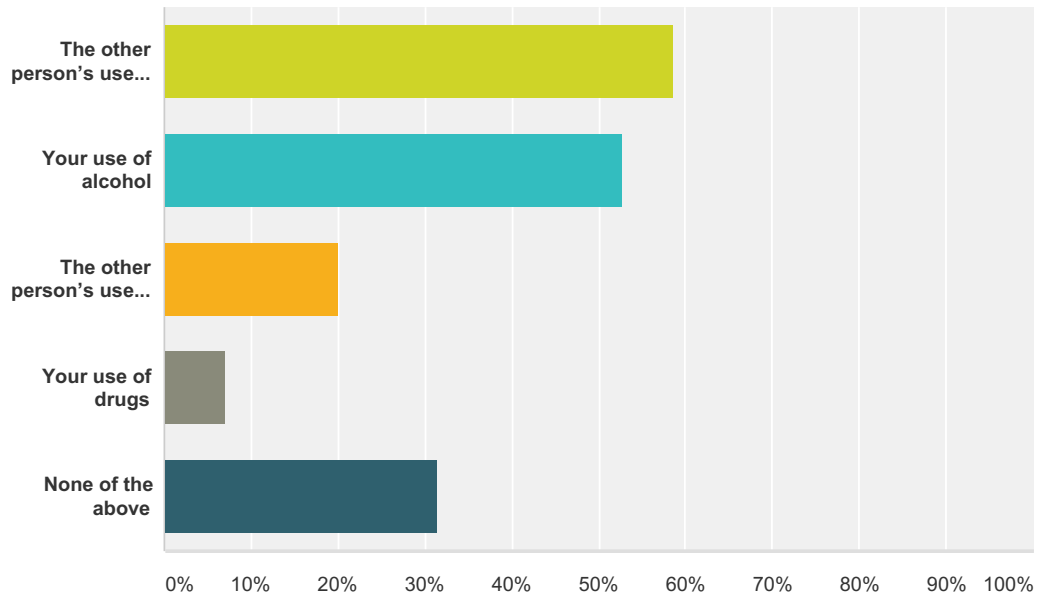

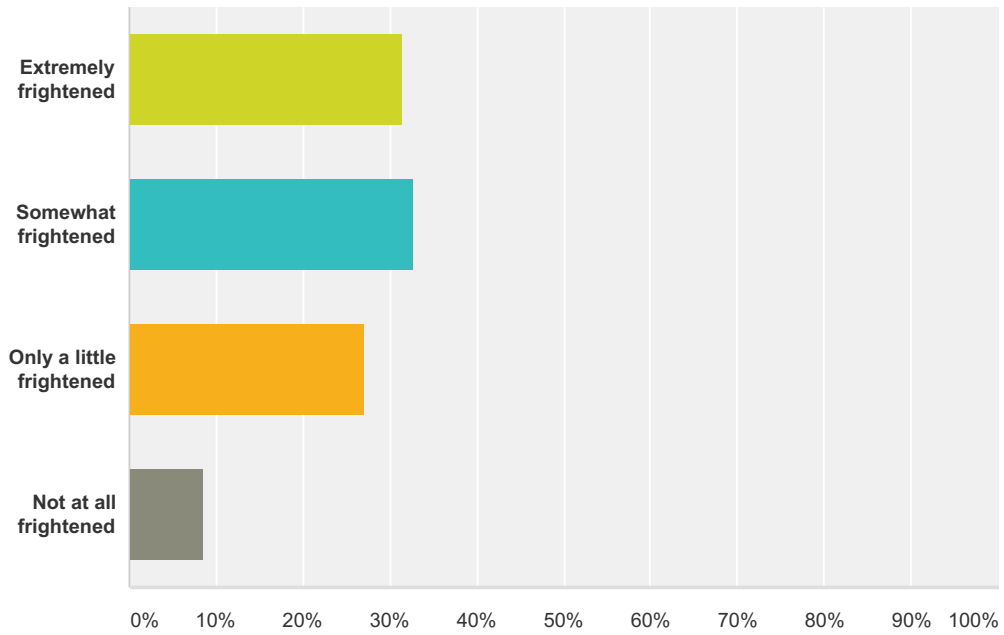

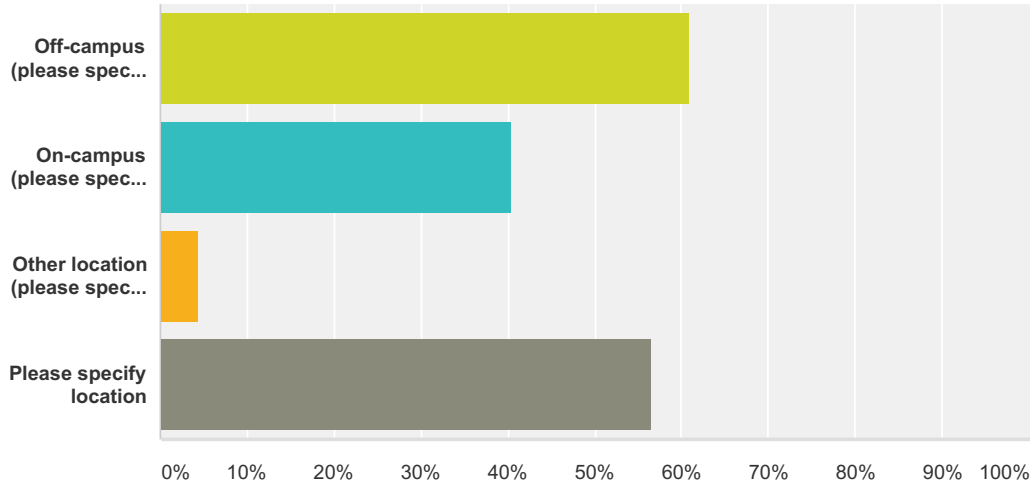

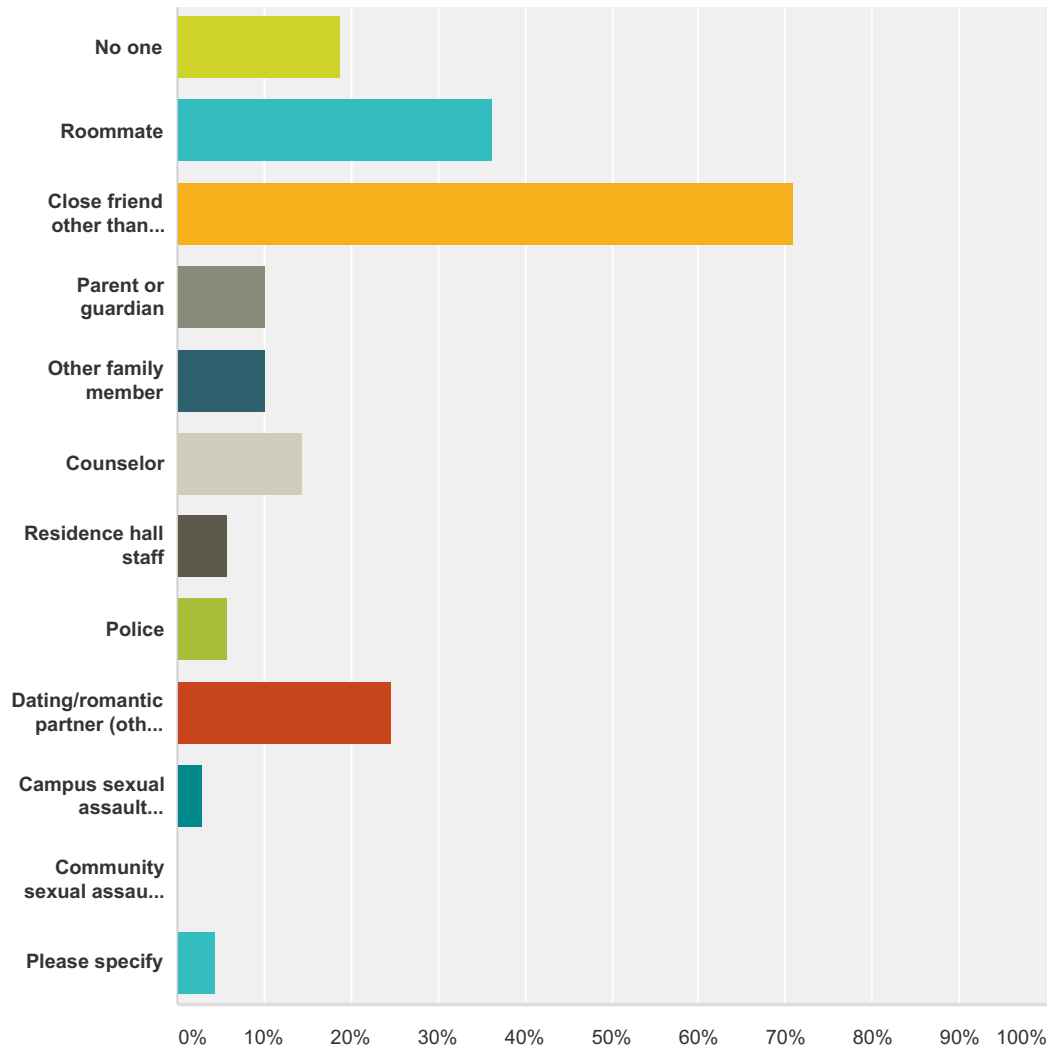

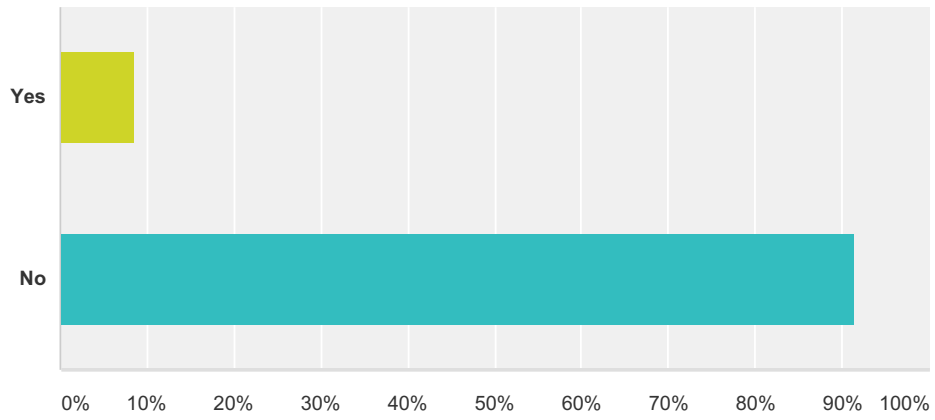

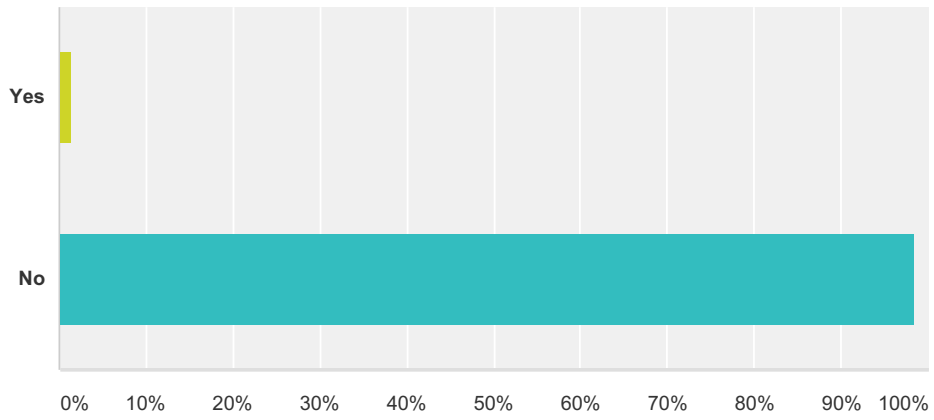

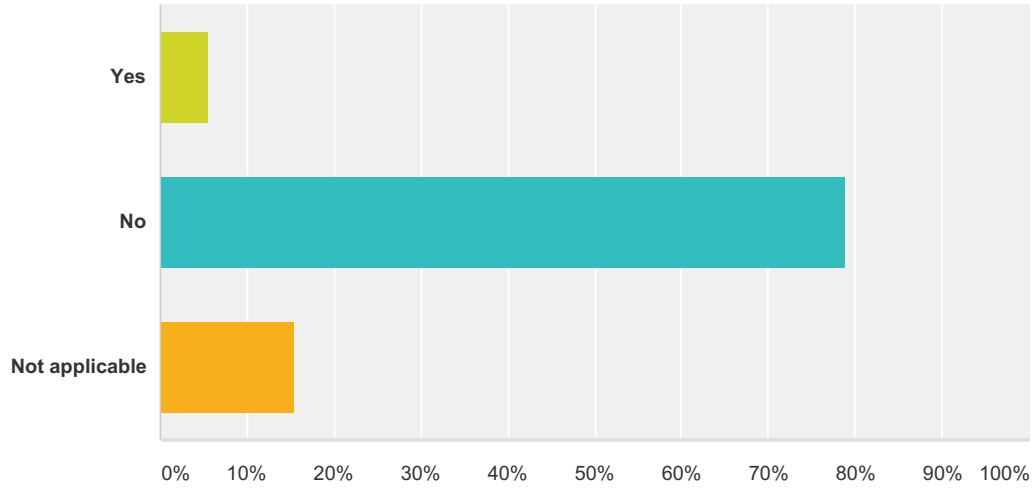

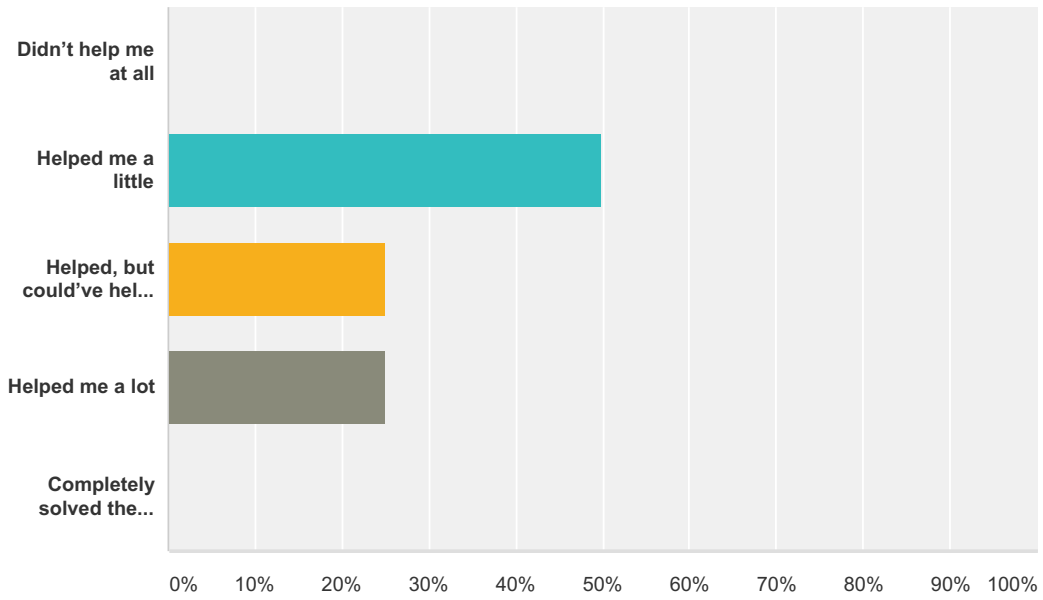

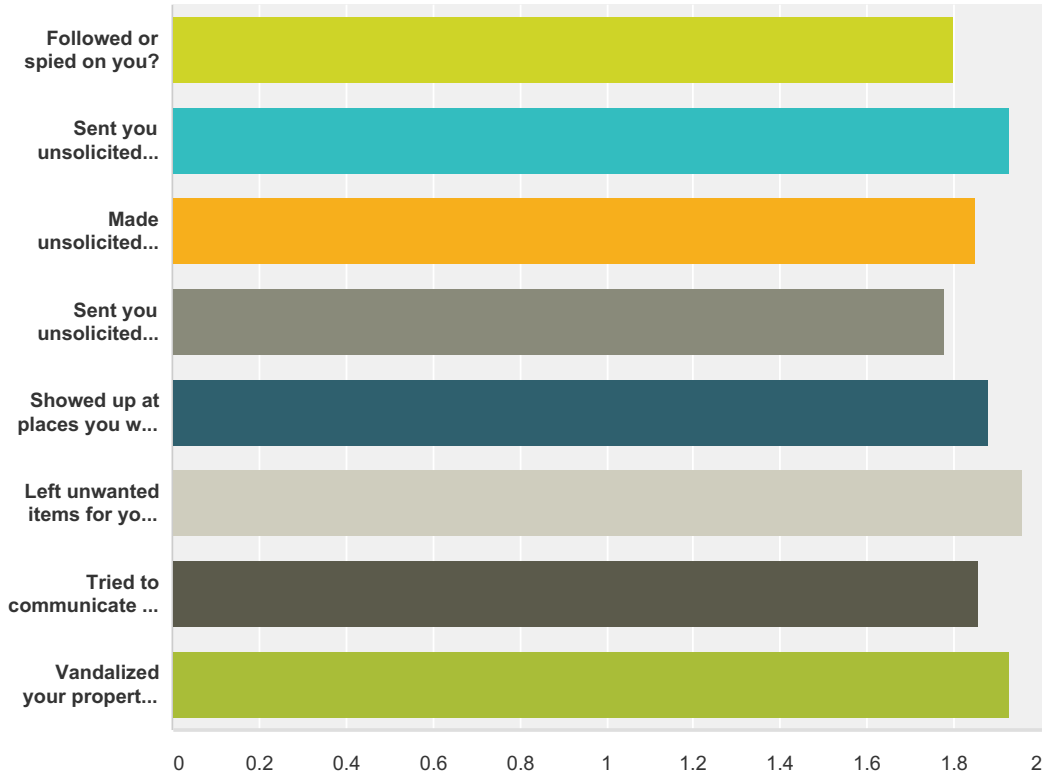

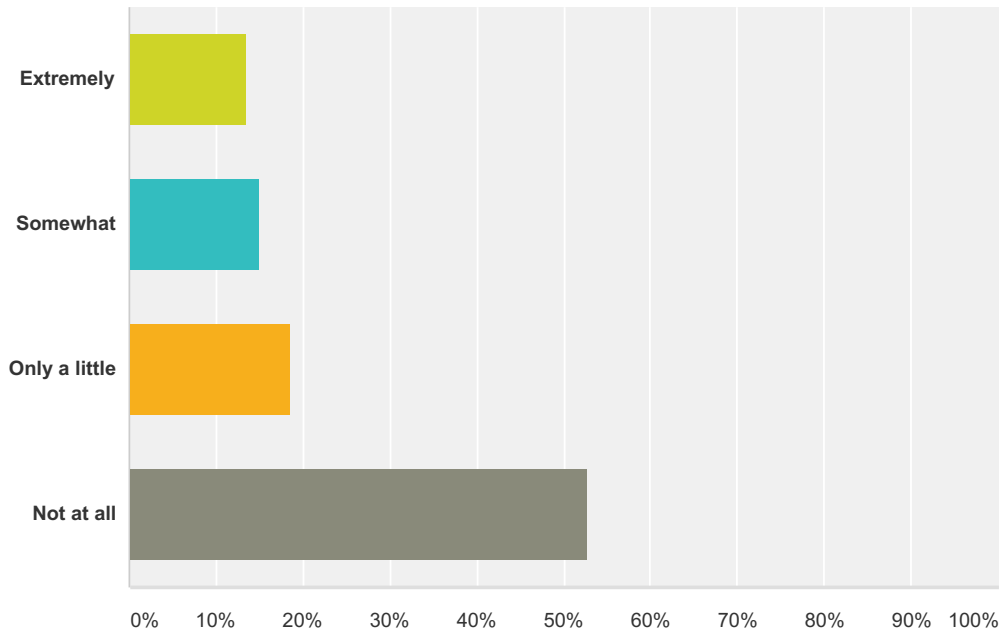

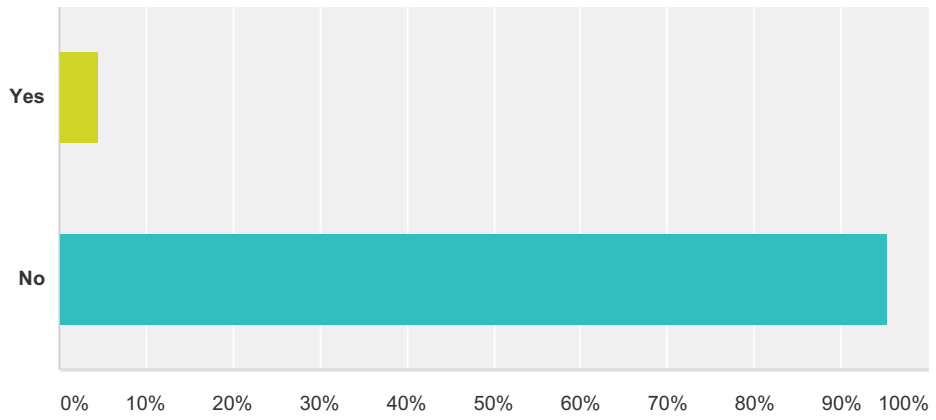

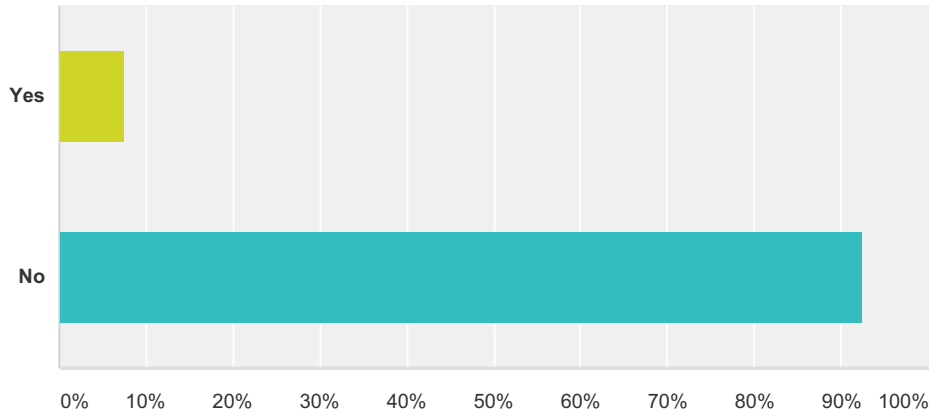

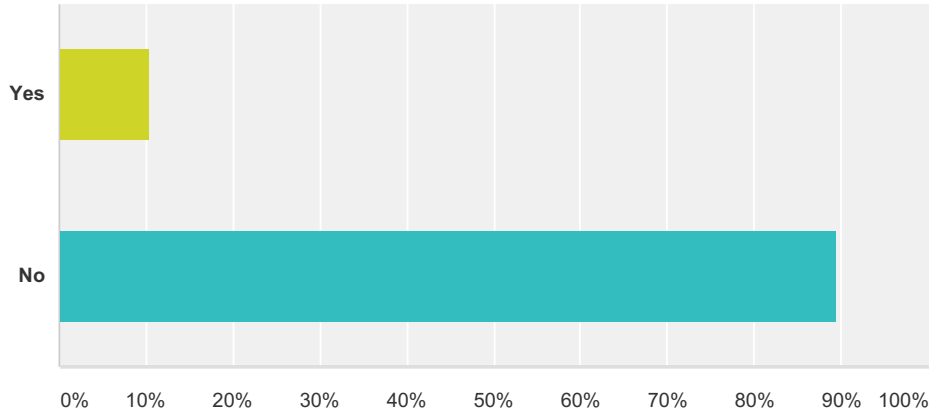

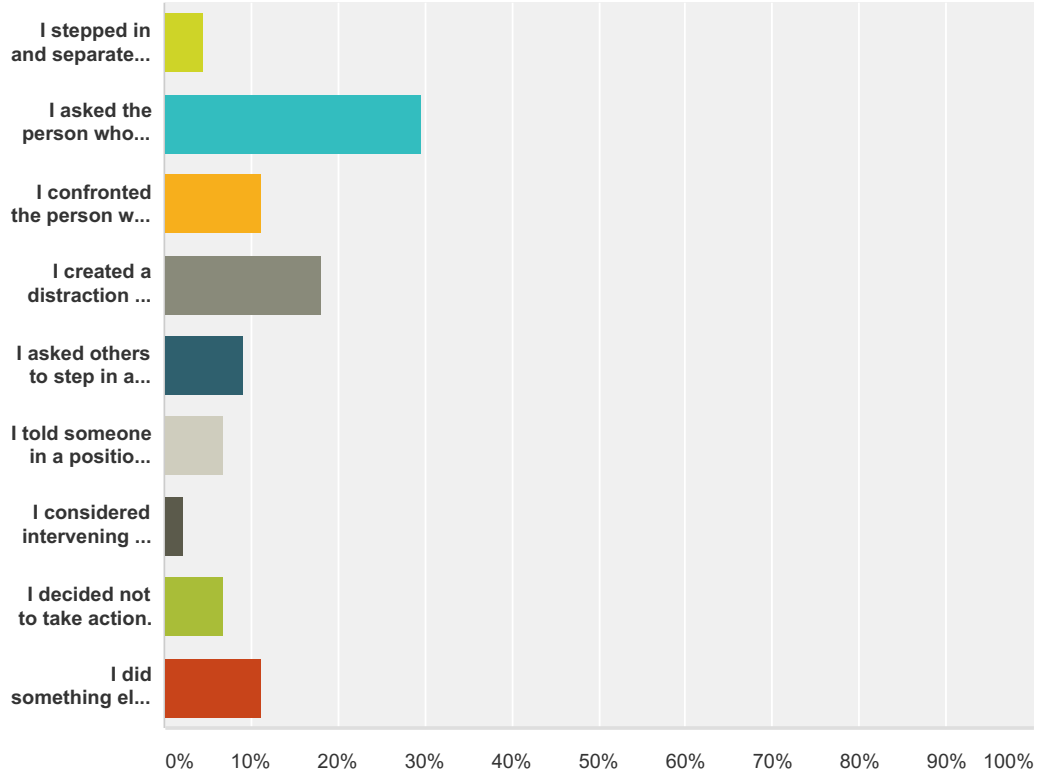

**Q71 Select the one response that most closely resembles your actions in response to this situation:**

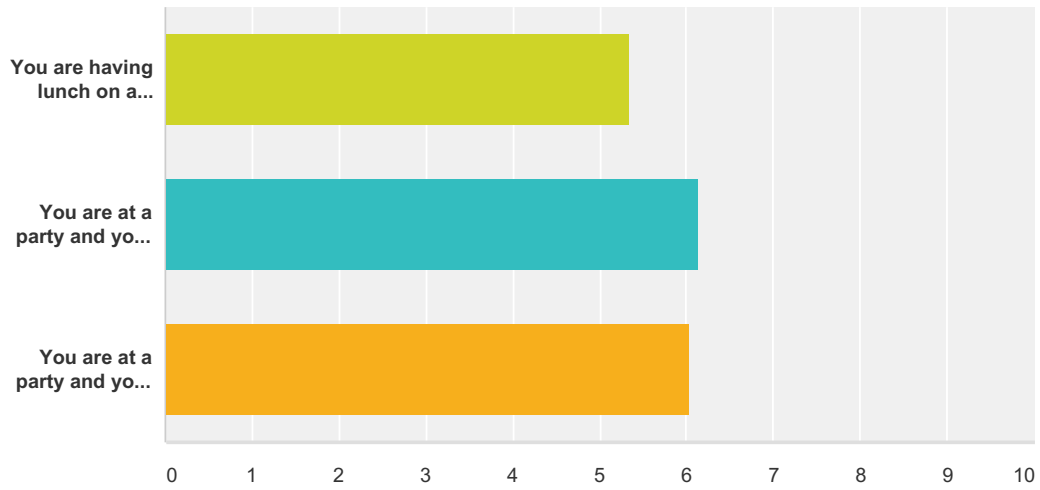

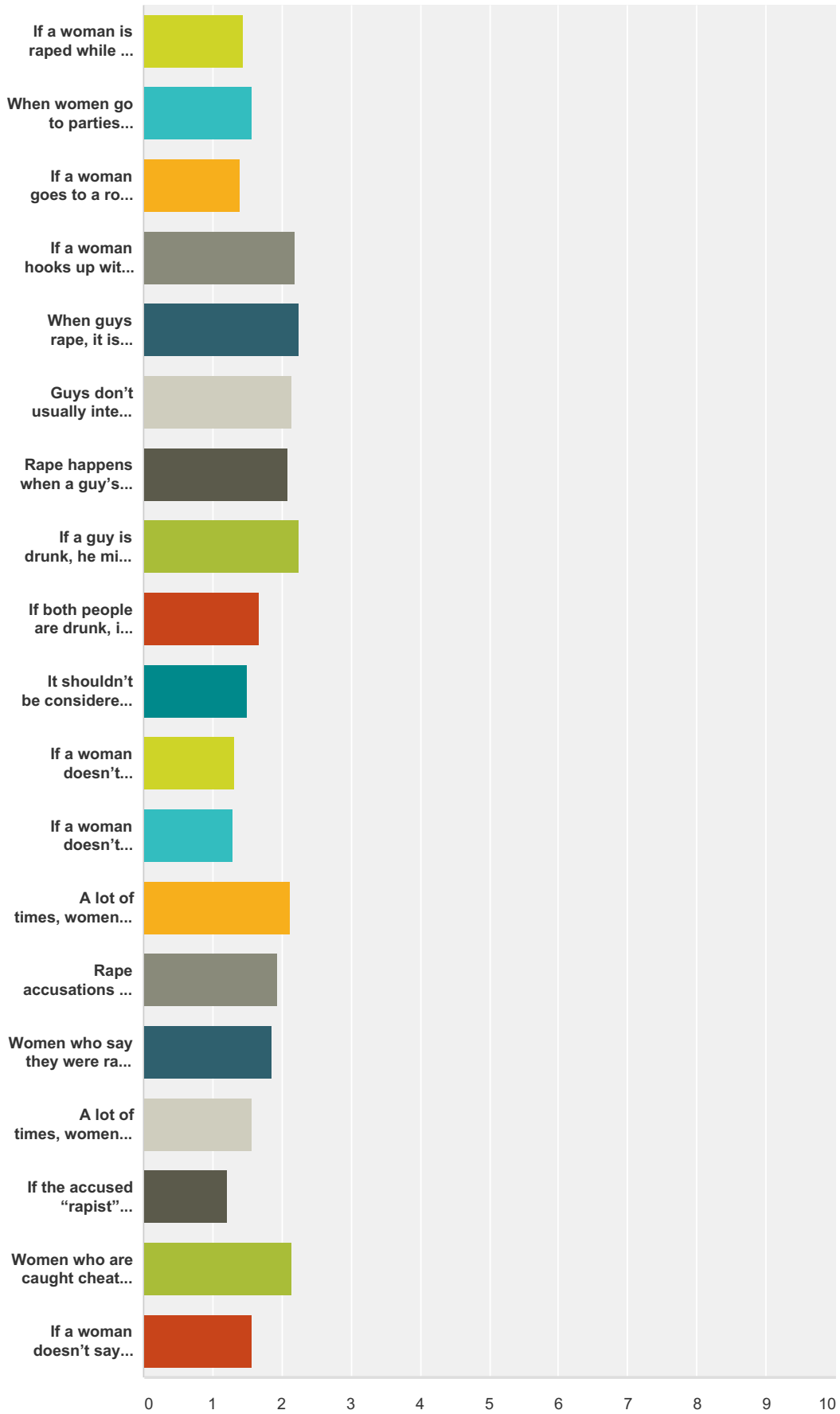
