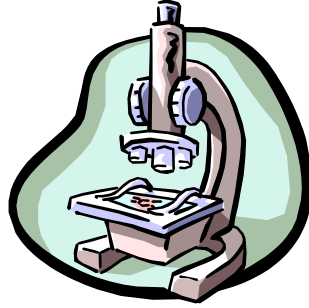


STUDYING FOR SCIENCE

Read your textbook

- Do your reading before the lecture so you will better understand the material being presented in class.
- Pay attention to pictures, diagrams, and graphs in addition to the words.
- Summarize what you read. Determine the main points and supporting evidence.
- Copy important formulas to use for your homework problems.
- Read material a second time **AFTER** the lecture.

Take good notes

- Use different color pens to note important formulas and concepts.
- Diagram important processes.
- Connect what you learn in class to your readings.

Prepare for exams

- Don't cram for a test. Study over 5 days doing a little each day. This will give you time to ask questions of your professor before the test.
- Redraw important diagrams to activate your memory.
- Review each chapter, focusing on one important concept in each section.
