




While enrolled at FSU, would you have considered yourself an "actively involved" student outside of the classroom?

Which activities did you regard as important aspects of your undergraduate experience?












Have you attained a leadership position at your current job?


How long have you been employed by your current employer?




Is your current position related to your undergraduate field(s) of study?






