Writing Placement Based on Test Scores Framingham State University

In the chart below, you will find information about your placement in Framingham State's first-year writing courses based on test scores you may have.

SAT Reading (Scores Since March 2016)	 With a score of 32 or higher, you are eligible for placement in ENWR 110 Composition II; you do not need to take the writing placement exam. Notes: Course credit is not given for ENWR 105 Composition I. If you received a score lower than 32, you will need to take the writing placement exam. 	You are not allowed to test out of ENWR 110 Composition II nor can you be waived from completing ENWR 110 Composition II based solely on SAT scores.
SAT Critical Reading (Scores Prior to March 2016 Test)	 With a score higher than 600, you are eligible for placement in ENWR 110 Composition II; you do not need to take the writing placement exam. Notes: Course credit is not given for ENWR 105 Composition I. If you received a score of 600 or lower, you will need to take the writing placement exam. 	You are not allowed to test out of ENWR 110 Composition II nor can you be waived from completing ENWR 110 Composition II based solely on SAT scores.
AP Language and Composition	 With a score of 3, you are eligible for placement in ENWR 110 Composition II; you do not need to take the writing placement exam. Note: You will also receive transfer credit for an English elective (noted as ENGL 1TR English Elective on your transcript). 	With a score of 4 or 5, you receive transfer credit for ENWR 110 Composition II, and you have completed your General Education Core Writing requirement.
AP Literature and Composition	This exam has no effect on your placement in or credit for first-year writing courses. With a score of 3 or higher, however, you receive transfer credit for an English elective (noted as ENGL 1TR English Elective on your transcript).	
CLEP College Composition	This exam has no effect on your placement in ENWR 110 Composition II. If you have taken the CLEP College Composition exam and received a score lower than 50, you still need to take the writing placement exam.	With a score of 50 or higher, you receive transfer credit for ENWR 110 Composition II, and you have completed your General Education Core Writing requirement.
